Outdoor service (weather permitting)
We hope to gather outside, probably on the East Side of the church!

- Communion: Pre-loaded communion packets will be set out on tables for you to pick up. Or, bring your own elements.

- Infant Baptism: We are aiming to baptize Isaac Van Oss, son of Phillip and Heather, and Olsen Rapisarda, daughter of Matt and Ashley.

Practical things: Bring chairs. Bring an umbrella in case it rains or is hot. Don't wear fancy shoes in case it's hot and the parking lot is "melty." There will be a section for chairs to be spread out with generous space between them. Further back in the parking lot, there will space for people to sit in their cars. Council members will be there to direct the flow of things.

Safety Things: Please, the only way we can do this is if we all cheerfully keep safe practices. We are following our best medical advice from professionals we know and trust. So, masks are recommended for the safety of others. Everything from communion to the infant baptisms will be done with special care for the safety of everyone. There are beloved ones among us who should not attend. We intend to rejoice in the Lord with peace, love and gladness. We also must be generous and wise. Thank-you.
