FALL PROGRAMMING, FAITH STEPS

At our meetings of the last month, the Council and the Elders talked and prayed and sketched out some definitions to our Fall ministry programming.

Worship: We intend to continue with the every-other-week rotation for the near future, with a possible outdoor service for all of us together in early September.

Education: We are still in much discussion about this, but we are intending to take guidance from the medical professionals of our church and the policies and practices of our local school systems. We want to wait just a bit longer to put a definite plan in place, since things are changing week-by-week. We will keep everyone posted, and either in-person (with strong safety practices) or online intend to provide resources and Bible/doctrinal substance for our children and young people.

Wednesday nights: We are considering a range of options that will allow us to serve our community well and safely. A team of people from our church is working out the details, so we will update everyone as we move forward.
